Duration of Contract	The recruitment will initially be for a period of eleven months which shall be extendable to next three years or till sanction of that post in ROP under NHM as well as availability of fund, whichever is earlier subjected to following conditions:- a. Satisfactory performance b. Continued requirement of the position c. Availability of fund and approval of the position by Government of India in RoP of NHM

Eligibility Criteria:**Category – (UR-14, MBC-07, BC-05, SC-06, WBC-01)****Maximum age :- 55 Years as on 01.08.2018****Eligibility/Qualification:****Essential:**

- MD in Dermatology/DNB in Dermatology from a recognized Institute/University.
OR
Diploma in Venerology & Dermatology (DVD) from a recognized Institute/University.
- The candidates with MD in dermatology/DNB in dermatology will be given preference.
- The above qualification must be registered with Bihar Medical Council or Medical Council of India before joining.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- S/he will be responsible for managing skin, venereal disease and leprosy OPD at district hospital.
- S/he will be responsible for managing leprosy patients and provide technical support to District Leprosy Officer (DLO).
- S/he will be in-charge of ICTC centre at district hospital.
- S/he will also support Adolescent Friendly Health Clinics (AFHC) at DH and other identified services.
- Any other duty requiring his or her services as assigned by concerned superior authority from time to time.

Performance appraisal:
